## **CONDITION SUMMARY:**

Situation: The steering wheel Volume/Mode and/or Voice Activation control switch may not be functioning correctly.

Cause: This may be caused by a poor ground.

Action: Should a customer express this concern, follow the Service Instruction outlined below.

### PARTS:

NOTE: vehicles with heated steering wheel require: In Car Entertainment (ICE; left-hand) switch, Overlay harness - Steering wheel, and Overlay harness - Touch Screen; do NOT replace steering wheel or Instrument Cluster menu control (right-hand) switch replacement.

NOTE: vehicles with non-heated steering wheel require: Steering wheel - Non-heated, In Car Entertainment (ICE; left-hand) switch, Overlay harness - Steering wheel, and Overlay harness -Touch Screen. The right-hand ICE switch MUST be retained from the old steering wheel.

NOTE: vehicles with heated steering wheel require: one (1) In Car Entertainment (ICE) switch (LH); one (1) steering wheel harness; and one (1) Touch Screen overlay harness.

## **SERVICE INSTRUCTION:**



Changes to the Service Instruction are extensive and therefore NOT highlighted.

1Remove the Touch Screen (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 415-01: Information and Entertainment System).

2Remove the steering wheel (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 211-04: Steering Column).


3Remove the Instrument Cluster (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 413-01: Instrument Cluster).

**4**Remove the electrical connector C2LS41 (Green) from the module steering wheel.




5 NOTE: observe the terminal size as they are different at each end on the new overlay harness.


Using pin out tool 418-595 back out the wire from cavity 15.



**6**Insert the overlay wiring harness into cavity 15 of electrical connector C2LS41 (Green).




**7**Tape back the now redundant electrical connector to existing wiring harness.


- **8**Route the overlay wiring harness to follow the existing wiring harness.
  - Tape to existing wiring harness at 100mm intervals.




**9**Route the wiring harness **behind** Instrument Cluster mounting bracket and secure with tape in three places.



- **10**Route the wiring harness to follow existing wiring harness to the Touch Screen mounting plate.
  - Tape back to the existing wiring harness at 100mm intervals.



- 11Locate the electrical harness connector C2MC02A (Grey) from the Touch Screen.
  - Using pin out tool 418-595, back out the wire from cavity 13.
  - · Insert the overlay wiring harness in cavity 13.
- **12**Tape back any excess wires to the existing wiring harness to include the redundant wire.



- **13**Install the Touch Screen (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 415-01: Information and Entertainment System).
- **14**Install the Instrument Cluster (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 415-01: Information and Entertainment System).

15 NOTE: non-heated steering wheel only: install new Steering wheel - Non-heated, In Car Entertainment (ICE; left-hand) switch, Overlay harness - Steering wheel. Transfer the Instrument Cluster menu control (right-hand) switch from the original steering wheel.

NOTE: make sure that the harness is correctly routed and clipped into the steering wheel retainers.

**Non-heated steering wheel only:** install the new In Car Entertainment (ICE; left-hand) switch, Overlay harness - Steering wheel, and original Instrument Cluster menu control (right-hand) switch to the new steering wheel (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 211-04: Steering Column).

16 NOTE: heated steering wheel only: install new In Car Entertainment (ICE; left-hand) switch, Overlay harness - Steering wheel. Retain the original steering wheel and Instrument Cluster menu control (right-hand) switch.

NOTE: make sure that the harness is correctly routed and clipped into the steering wheel retainers.

**Heated steering wheel only:** install the new In Car Entertainment (ICE; left-hand) switch and Overlay harness - Steering wheel to the original steering wheel (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 211-04: Steering Column).

17Install the steering wheel (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 211-04: Steering Column).

18Test the steering wheel ICE switch functions.
