Technical Background

Certain driving conditions can cause the ECM to adapt idle quality incorrectly.

This TSB replaces TSB 2033647: 24 ECM adaptation for 2014 R8 V10 and V10 Plus with S-Tronic only. ECM adaption is no longer required for R8 V10 and R8 V10 plus vehicles with both manual and S-Tronic transmissions.
