
2016 CX-5 INTERMITTENT NO CRANK / NO START

Some customers may complain about an intermittent no crank/no start. This may be caused by instrument panel wiring harness connector C-11 not fully seated (locked).

IDS may show several U codes stored in memory. Properly secure the instrument panel wiring harness connector C-11 to resolve customer complaint.
