

Spare Parts Requirements for Front Power Seat Frame (with memory): Checking Existing Type (49/16)

Subject: **Front power seat frame (with memory)**

Information: **Supersessions to the seat adjustment motor on the spare parts requirements for the front power seat frame.**

Date of Introduction: As of October 10, 2014, the modified front power seat frame is installed as standard.

Remedial Action: If a front power seat frame needs to be replaced on a vehicle produced before October 10, 2014, check the seat frame part number:

a) Part number of the existing seat frame is 970.521.201.03 or lower.

This is the **old** seat adjuster, the following steps must be performed:

- A **new** type of Seat Frame (Part No.: **298.881.105.A** or higher):
- The existing wiring harness with four-pin connector must be replaced by a new harness with two-pin connector. (Part No.: **7P5.971.384.P**)
- The Seat Memory Control Unit must be inspected. The part number must be at least **970.618.537.08 or higher**. If it is not, the Seat Memory Control Unit must also be replaced.

b) Part number of the existing seat adjuster is 298.881.105.A or higher.

The new type of seat adjuster is already installed. **End** of remedial action.
