A/C Not Blowing Cold Air

AFFECTED VEHICLES

2016 Civic

We're getting reports of the A/C not blowing cold air. From their basic checks, service techs are noticing there's refrigerant oil on the radiator fan shroud and surrounding areas, indicating a leak.

Our investigation shows that the low pressure suction hose may be rubbing against the bracket for the expansion tank outlet pipe. This rubbing comes from a variation in the hose profile. If the rubbing is severe enough, it could lead to leaks.



Fortunately, there's just a very small quantity of those hoses in the market, but if you happen to get a vehicle with this issue, then replace that hose and make sure the new one doesn't make contact with the bracket or surrounding hose clamps.
