Today, October 4, 2016, American Honda Motor, Co., Inc. is announcing a product update for 110 model year 2016 Honda Odyssey vehicles to prevent or correct possible rust and corrosion from the left sliding passenger door in the affected area. Any affected vehicles in dealer stock should be fixed prior to selling.

# **Basic Problem**

During manufacturing, three spot welds inside the top of the driver's side sliding door were not properly finished with primer. The untreated metal is susceptible to corrosion.

# The Repair

The top of the left side passenger door will be fixed on the inside of the window channel. To minimize the possibility of rust or corrosion, the area must be repaired of any current corrosion, cleaned and primer applied to the metal surfaces affected.

### Service Bulletin

Service bulletin 16-079, *Product Update: Primer Not Applied to Sliding Door Spot Welds* has been posted to the Service Information System today in support of this proactive campaign. It includes material, warranty and repair procedure information related to this product update.

### Parts and Materials Information
