### **Background**

American Honda (AHM) is investigating certain 2016 MDXs with a client complaint of a front brake noise. The noise can be described as clicking, clacking or clunking due to pad shift. This pad shift noise usually occurs when turning or going straight. To fully understand the cause of this condition, AHM would like to collect specific parts from the vehicle prior to you attempting a repair of any kind.

### Qualifiers

AHM is interested ONLY if the vehicle meets the following requirements:

- 1. Must be able to duplicate the noise.
- 2. VIN must be after 5FRYD4H\*\*GB012605 (4WD) or 5FRYD3H\*\*GB003944 (2WD)
- 3. No previous/current wheel bearing noise related repairs.
- 4. No brake system repairs.
- 5. No brake system service performed except for the routine cleaning & lubing of the brake pads (Molykote).
