Dear Honda Dealer:

Honda is launching a SAFETY RECALL on the Accessory Rear Trunk Base for PCX125/150 scooters for a potential defect that may allow the trunk to fall off the scooter while riding. A fallen trunk in the roadway poses a safety hazard to other roadway users.

Effective immediately, YOU MUST NOT SELL the following Accessory Rear Trunk Base:

#### AFFECTED PART NUMBERS

08L71-K35-J00 – Rear trunk base (PCX150)

08L70-KZY-910 – Rear trunk base (PCX150)

81200-KWN-780 – Base, rear carrier (component of above kits)

(Although the above kits are sold for PCX150, some may have been installed on PCX125.)

#### SERVICE BULLETIN

*Service Bulletin PCX125/150 #1*, which includes the affected part numbers, interim repair procedure, parts information, as well as warranty claim information, is forthcoming.

#### PARTS INFORMATION

All dealers with affected accessory inventory must not sell or install the affected parts. Make sure the above part numbers are removed from any internet parts advertising by your dealership. Dealer parts return information is forthcoming. It is expected that an updated rear trunk base will be available early summer 2016.

#### CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

AHM intends to mail customer letters to all owners of PCX125 and PCX150 scooters as early as possible, subject to State registration information. Customers will be informed that their scooter may be affected by a safety related defect and advised to discontinue using the rear trunk, or have a Honda dealer temporarily secure the rear trunk to the trunk base until the update part is available.

Once the updated rear trunk base is available, customers will receive a second notification advising them to have a Honda dealer replace the rear trunk base.

Make sure all departments in your dealership are aware of this action.
