

### Service Procedure

**Note:** If the vehicle is equipped with splash guards, follow the procedure below. If the vehicle DOES NOT have splash guards installed, close out this field action and return the vehicle to the customer.


1. Raise vehicle.



2. Remove the front splash shield screws (1) and drill out rivet (2).

Note: If the finish is damaged from drilling out the rivet, use touch up paint to prevent any corrosion issues.

3. Discard the screws removed from the front splash shield.

4. Install 2 push pin retainers in the location shown above (1).

- 5. Install a new screw with washer in the location shown above.
- 6. Repeat the above steps for the opposite side.
- 7. Remove the rear splash shield screws (4) and save 2 for re-installation to the inner wheel well.


8. Remove the retaining screw clip and discard.

9. Install the 2 retaining screws removed from step 7 and install to inner wheel well screw holes.





- 10. Install a push pin retainer at the location shown.
- 11. Repeat steps 6-10 for the other side.
- 12. Clean any adhesive residue left from the splash shields with general purpose adhesive cleaner.
- 13. Lower vehicle.

#### **Dealer Responsibility**

Whenever a vehicle subject to this service update enters your vehicle inventory, or is in your facility for service in the future, and the vehicle is still covered under the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, you must take the steps necessary to be sure the service update correction has been made before selling or releasing the vehicle.
