PSS 91 Audio volume stays muted after vehicle is reversed

Condition

- The audio volume stays muted after the vehicle is reversed then driven forward (Figure 1).
- The issue can be intermittent and can happen with any audio source.
- The issue can be recreated with the following process: Allow the car systems to go to sleep, then quickly enter the vehicle, start the engine immediately, and put the car in reverse. After the backup camera is activated, drive the vehicle forward until the image is deactivated. The audio will stay muted. The issue occurs when the backup camera is activated and the MMI is still booting up.
