Some customers may complain about an inoperative power liftgate (PLG). DTC U3003:16 (Power liftgate (PLG) control module power supply voltage low input) is stored in memory. This may be caused by low battery voltage.

Repair Procedure

- I. Recharge the vehicle battery.
- 2. Confirm the lift gate is closed, disconnect the negative battery terminal.
- 3. Clear the KAM by stepping on the brake pedal and holding high beam on for 1 minute.
- 4. Reconnect the negative terminal and confirm PLG operation.
- 5. Clear DTC's.
