Dear Dealer Partners,

I wanted to share some news about our latest progress toward resolving the TDI emissions issues. Today, the U.S. District Court in San Francisco held a status conference on the TDI diesel matter.

As noted today in the Court, we have submitted a proposed remedy for the affected 3.0L TDI vehicles to the Environmental Protection Agency and the California Air Resources Board. This is now undergoing a thorough review, which includes durability testing, and we look forward to the next status update hearing on this matter on August 25.

As you know, earlier this week we reached a proposed settlement with government authorities and the Plaintiffs' Steering Committee for our 2.0L TDI vehicles. You can read the details at www.vwcourtsettlement.com.

Over the next month, customers and the public will have an opportunity to review and comment on the agreements. On July 26, the Court has scheduled a hearing on preliminary approval for the settlement. Volkswagen and Audi will begin the 2.0L TDI settlement program as soon as the Court grants final approval, which will occur in the fall of 2016 at the earliest.

As I've said from the beginning, you didn't cause this problem, but you are playing a critical role in helping us fix it. Your effort, your execution and your hard work in this complicated and difficult process exemplifies the best that this great brand stands for. Thank you.
