Subject: **Update on TDI Emissions Compliance Issue**

Yesterday, Volkswagen again appeared before U.S. District Court Judge Charles Breyer, who presides over hundreds of civil lawsuits pending in the Multi-District Litigation (MDL) in San Francisco, regarding the TDI emissions issue. The Judge announced that the parties had reached certain agreements in principle to resolve matters relating to 2.0L TDI vehicles.

These agreements in principle are an important step on the road to making things right. Volkswagen is committed to earning back the trust of its customers, dealers, regulators, the American public, and you, our employees. As noted today in court, customers in the U.S. do not need to take any action at this time.

The court emphasized that parties' discussions regarding the agreements in principle must remain confidential. As a result, we are not in a position to provide further details. As soon as we can provide you with more information, we will share it with you.
