2016 Golf, Golf Sportwagen, GTI, Golf R, Jetta, Tiguan, Beetle, Beetle Convertible, Passat - Android Auto Connection Issue After Updating Some Samsung Phones to Android SW Version 6.0.1 - Marshmallow

- After updating a Samsung phone to Android version 6.0.1 Marshmallow, the phone may not connect to Android Auto in the same manner as it did before.
- The phone will not be listed in the device list until you switch "USB Tethering" ON.
- After disconnecting the phone or switching OFF the car, "USB Tethering" is automatically Switched OFF. Which means you have to switch "USB Tethering" back ON every time you connect to Android Auto.
- When the phone is connecting after switching ON "USB Tethering," the radio may display "Device Not Supported," but this message will disappear and the phone will then be listed in the device list.
- This is a known issue with Android and a resolution is in the works.
