Some vehicles in the affected VIN list for this Quarantine may now be registered and given to a Customer. Make sure that you do a check of the Online Dealer Warranty (ODW) database to make sure that all necessary work is done to every vehicle.

Reason for this Quarantine Notice

A quantity of Rapide, Rapide S and Lagonda Taraf vehicles have been released from the factory with fuses of an incorrect rating installed at two locations in the boot fuse box. Please refer to the separately published list of VINs and do the Workshop Procedure that follows to all of the vehicles in the list to replace the fuses with items of the correct rating.

Workshop Procedure

1. Open the boot lid.
2. Remove the right rear carpet from the side of the boot (refer to Workshop Manual procedure 01.05.FP).
3. Use a fuse removal tool to remove the 25A fuse from fuse location number 16 (item 1, Figure 1). Replace the fuse with a fuse of 5A rating.

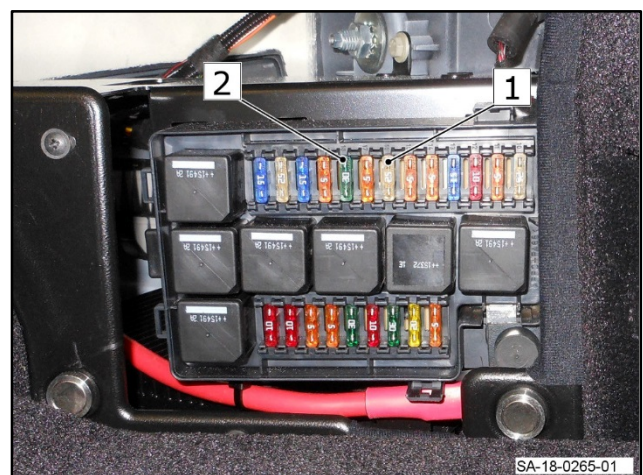

4. Use a fuse removal tool to remove the 30A fuse from fuse location number 18 (item 2, Figure 1). Replace the fuse with a fuse of 5A rating.
5. Install the right rear carpet.
