
Subject: Radio Continues to Play, Retained Accessory Power (RAP) Will Not Cancel After Driver Door is Opened,
DTCs U1530 or U1534 Present

Involved Region or Country	North America
Condition	Some customers may comment that when parking and turning off the vehicle, the radio continues to play after the driver door is opened. Technicians may find DTCs U1530 or U1534 present.
Cause	The cause of the condition may be a power window motor control circuit board that may have a defect which doesn't allow communication to the BCM for window indexing. For proper operation, the BCM needs to see the indexing signal to know that the door is open, and cancel RAP.

Correction

Follow SI diagnostics to verify condition of no window indexing communication to BCM.



For vehicles exhibiting the condition, replace the driver side door power window regulator/motor assembly. Refer to Front Side Door Window Regulator Replacement in SI.
