Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on the visibility with the body plugs on vehicles equipped with 6 inch oval accessory chrome assist steps.

This is due to the body plugs being black in color reflecting off of the chrome steps.

Recommendation/Instructions

Replace the black color body plugs with one of the plugs that pertains to the RPOs listed below.
