Subject: Dome Lamps Flash/Flicker On and Off when Operating Brake Pedal or Turn Signal

Attention: This PI also applies to any of the above models that may be Export vehicles.

This PI has been revised to update information under Condition/Concern 1 and Recommendation/Instructions 2. Please discard PI1268A.

Condition/Concern 1

Some owners may comment when the dome lamps are off, if the brake pedal is applied or turn signal is operated, the dome lamp may flash on and off in any of the passenger rows. This issue may also occur when other electrical loads are operated, but the brake pedal and left turn signal are the most common. There will be no DTCs related to this issue.

Recommendation/Instructions 1

To correct this concern, replace both front overhead console lamps with GM P/N 23104411.

Condition/Concern 2 (Excluding Escalade Models)

Some customers may comment on a flicker or pulsing from **bright to dim** when the rear seat entertainment (RSE) reading/dome lamps **are in use** with turn signal or brake activation. This condition will only exist on vehicles with RSE (RPO U42) and incandescent (Not LED) tail lamps.

This condition may be due to sensitivity of the U42 overhead console to normal voltage fluctuations generated with activation of the brake or turn lamps. The

standard overhead is tolerant of these voltage changes and therefore is unaffected.

Recommendation/Instructions 2

Important: Do not replace the BCM, U42 overhead console or any other parts in an attempt to solve this lamp flickering condition.

This condition has been resolved in production and updated service parts will not produce this problem. Replace the affected "Display, Video Aux" with the parts listed within the Electronic Parts Catalog.
