Condition	Some customers may comment that the sunroof or sunshade is inoperative when the sunroof switch is pressed. Technicians may notice DTC U151B code set.
Cause	This condition may be caused by a faulty sunroof or sunshade window motor.
Additional Options	RPO C3U or CF5

Correction

If the sunroof or sunshade has been validated to be the cause of concern, the motor must be replaced.

Service Procedure

- 1. If the BCM is confirmed to be reporting DTC U151B, replace the sunroof motor. Refer to Sunroof Window Motor Replacement in SI.
- 2. The Sunroof Motor/Actuator Initialization/Teach Process must be performed after motor replacement.
