### **CONDITION SUMMARY:**

Situation: A 'rattle' noise may be evident from the glovebox area. Upon further inspection, checking the glovebox results in no fault found.

Cause: This may be caused by the Body Control Module (BCM) cover in the front passenger footwell which can become loose and generate unwanted noise.

Action: Should a Customer express this concern, follow the Service Instruction below.


NOTE: DDW requires the use of causal part numbers. Labor only claims must show the causal part number with a quantity of zero.

#### **SERVICE INSTRUCTION:**

- 1. Open the front right door.
- 2. Remove the Body Control Module (BCM) cover from the passenger footwell.



- 3. Visually inspect the position of the wiring harness as it may be positioned over the floor carpet as illustrated.


  - If the wiring harness is not positioned over the floor carpet, go to Step 5.
    If the wiring harness is positioned over the floor carpet, go to Step 4.




**4.** Position the wiring harness behind the floor carpet as illustrated.



**5.** Install the BCM cover in the passenger footwell.



**6.** Visually check that there is no gap between the BCM cover and the floor carpet and that it is securely installed.



7. Close the front right door.
