Technical Background

The noise comes from the upper shock absorber mounting.

Production Solution

Optimized damper mounting gradually introduced in production.

Service

- 1. Determine the location of the noise (left rear or right rear) with a test drive.
- 2. Swap rear shock assemblies (with mounting) from right to left:
 - If the noise changes sides, replace the affected shock absorber mounting. Only optimized parts are available to order.
 - If the noise does not change sides, continue diagnosis.
