Service

Before proceeding, confirm the condition:

- If the red oil pressure warning light <u>is not on</u> and DTC <u>cannot</u> be reproduced:
 - Replace the rubber plug and spring (Figure 1).
- If the red oil pressure warning light is on and DTC can be reproduced:
 - Perform oil pressure test as instructed by GFF (with engine oil temperature at 80°C):

If oil pressure is <u>above</u> 0.7 bar after test: Replace the rubber plug and spring (Figure 1), then re-check oil pressure (with engine oil temperature at 80°C). The oil pressure must be above 1.4 bar at idle. If it is not, contact TAC.

If oil pressure is below 0.7 bar after test: Contact TAC.
