Condition	4581014 Some customers may comment that the cover material on the driver or passenger seat back is pulling loose around the easy entry release handle bezel. Examples of a cloth and leather seat cover are shown in the graphic above.		
Cause	The cause of the condition may be that the cover material is currently not secured underneath the handle.		

Correction

Install a push pin (referenced in the part table below) to secure the cover material to the underside plastic retainer following the Service Procedure below.

Service Procedure

Note: Graphics of this repair show the driver seat. Passenger seat would be similar.

1. Carefully remove the front seat back latch release handle bezel (1) on the affected seat. Refer to *Front Seat Back Latch Release Handle Bezel Replacement* in SI.

- 2. Reposition the seat cover material to align with edge of plastic retainer (1).

3. Mark a location on the material approximately 5 mm (1) from the inboard edge of the plastic retainer, and in-line with the existing hole in the handle base.



4. Using a 4.0 mm hole punch, punch a hole through BOTH the cover material and the plastic retainer (1).

- 6. Then, pulling the material and retainer farther upward, install the push pin in the existing hole of the handle base.
- 5. Install the push pin securing the material to the plastic retainer.

- 7. Reinstall the front seat back latch release handle bezel. Refer to Front Seat Back Latch Release Handle Bezel Replacement in SI.
- 8. With the bezel reinstalled, squeeze the outboard, upper seat cushion to ensure the containment is robust.
