SUBJECT:

Flash: Instrument Panel Cluster (IPC) Enhancement

OVERVIEW:

This bulletin involves reprogramming the IPC with the latest available software.

MODELS:

2015 - 2016 (JC)

Dodge Journey

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles within the following markets/countries: LATAM.

NOTE: This bulletin applies to vehicles equipped with Brazil Equipment Group (Sales Code AB6).

SYMPTOM/CONDITION:

The customer may describe that inside the IPC display, the spelling of the word "Trip" is misspelled "Viajem".

The following software enhancement is available:

This software will correct the spelling of the word "Trip" in the display of the IPC.

DIAGNOSIS:

Using a Scan Tool (wiTECH) with the appropriate Diagnostic Procedures available in TechCONNECT, verify all related systems are functioning as designed.

If the customer describes the symptom/condition listed above, perform the Repair Procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE:

NOTE: This IPC module cannot be flashed using a StarMOBILE device.

NOTE: Install a battery charger to ensure battery voltage does not drop below 13.2 volts. Do not allow the charging voltage to climb above 13.5 volts during the flash process.

NOTE: If this flash process is interrupted/aborted, the flash should be restarted.

- Reprogram the IPC with the latest software. Detailed instructions for flashing control modules using the wiTECH Diagnostic Application are available by selecting the application's "HELP" tab.
- 2. Clear any DTCs that may have been set in any module due to reprogramming. The wiTECH application will automatically present all DTCs after the flash and allow them to be cleared.

NOTE: The expected completion time for the flash download portion of this procedure is approximately 19 minutes. Actual flash download times may be affected by vehicle connection and network capabilities.

FAILURE CODE:

The dealer must choose which failure code to use. If the customer came in with an issue and if the dealer finds a software update to correct that issue, use failure code CC, for all other use failure code RF.

- If the customer's concern matches the SYMPTOM/CONDITION identified in the Service Bulletin, failure code CC is to be used.
- If an available flash is completed while addressing a different customer concern, failure code RF is to be used.
