- 3. Remove the spare tire assembly.



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- Install the spare tire strap into the tool stowage compartment location as shown.
- 5. Install the spare tire assembly.
- 6. Install the rear compartment floor trim panel.
- 7. Close hatch.

Dealer Responsibility
