Condition

The customer states that the MMI shows a message of "Initializing" when trying to access satellite radio. This occurs after selecting the "greyed out" radio source "SiriusXM" in the band selection (Figure 1). The customer's vehicle has MMI Radio Plus.

Technical Background

The MMI Radio Plus software incorrectly lists the band selection of "SiriusXM" when the vehicle is not equipped with the hardware to support this feature. The MMI Radio Plus is also known as the MIB2 High Scale system. It is important to note that some variants of the MIB2 High Scale system do have SiriusXM support, but the B9 A4 Premium package vehicles, which do not have the Convenience package, do not support Satellite Radio.

Service

The service solution is to update the MMI software to SW0081 to remove the SiriusXM from the radio source selections.



Do not perform this update to a vehicle which was correctly built to support SiriusXM. This update will remove the SiriusXM option for a car that was built with the feature. If this update is applied to the wrong vehicle it can cause damage to the MMI hardware causing the Satellite Radio feature to be permanently disabled.

Required equipment:

- ODIS Tester
- MIB2 High Scale Software Update on SD Card (See required parts & tools information table below)
- SVM code listed in steps below

Time to complete update:

• Approximately 90 minutes (includes S/W update and SVM work)

Repair procedure:

 Verify the customer's MMI requires the software update by going to the Main Menu>>Settings>>Left drawer option>>Version Information (Figure 2).

Software version 0061 is only the version which needs to be updated. If the MMI is at a level greater than 0061 (e.g. 0081, 0110, 0112, or 0118), then this TSB does not apply.

2. Obtain the SD card from the parts department (see parts and tools table below).

- 3. Connect a charger or battery maintainer to the vehicle that capable of maintaining the vehicle voltage at the appropriate levels (check current capacity of maintainer). Turn off all unnecessary battery consumers, such as LED DRL's, HVAC blower, Radio volume mute, etc.).
- 4. Follow the steps listed in the attached document "MIB2_High_Scale_Software_Update.pdf" to complete the update process. Enter the Red Engineering Update menu using the procedure listed in the instructions. Do not use the White Customer Update menu found under *Menu >> Settings*. Performing the update in the White Customer Update menu will only update the Bluetooth firmware and nothing else. Please perform the full update in the Red Engineering Update menu.
- 5. Perform the SVM feedback documentation using the SVM code MI2HSUS124A4.
