Condition	Some customers may comment on the following conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Malfunction Indicator Lamp Illuminated. Remote start will not start the vehicle. The Technician may find DTC P0132 and/or P223E set.
Cause	This may be caused by a voltage spike in the ECM, above the threshold value which will set the code P0132 or P223E.

Correction

If the DTC is set in two consecutive cycles, it will turn the MIL on. The MIL will reset after no fault 3 ignition cycles. DTC in history will clear after 40 ignition cycles. This set code will not impact the vehicle performance. If the conditions have been validated, the ECM must be updated.

Service Information

Update the ECM to the latest software and calibration available. Refer to *Engine Control Module Reprogramming with SPS* in SI.
