**Subject:** Information on Fuel Tank Replacement

<b>Involved Region or Country</b>	North America and all N.A. Export Regions
<b>Condition</b>	When replacing a fuel tank for service, a new design fuel tank and fuel feed pipe is required.
<b>Cause</b>	Tooling for 1st design fuel tank no longer exists.

### Correction

If the fuel tank is required for service, a new designed fuel tank and fuel feed pipe must be installed and the Chassis Control Module (Fuel Pump Control Module) needs to be reprogrammed with the latest calibrations.

### Service Procedure

Refer to *Fuel Tank Replacement* in SI.

**Important:** Verify the battery voltage is more than 12.6 volts but less than 15.5 volts before proceeding with reprogramming. The battery must be fully charged **BEFORE** reprogramming.

Before reprogramming the CCM (Fuel Pump Control Module), you must contact the Techline Customer Support Center (TCSC).

Refer to *Fuel Pump Control Module Reprogramming with SPS* in SI.

**Important:** During reprogramming, the battery voltage must be maintained within the proper range of 12.6-15.5 volts. **CONNECT** the approved Midtronics® PSC 550 Battery Maintainer (SPS Programming Support Tool (EL-49642) to the vehicle or the GR8 (EL50313) in the power supply mode.
