The new strut mounts are identified by a printed date code on the underside of the strut mount as shown in the photos and illustrations below. Strut mounts with a date code of 151225** (12/25/2015) and newer are the new type. (The 2-digit "Group" number (**) is insignificant for this bulletin.)
