AUDIO VOLUME NOT RESTORED AFTER MSA STOP, ENTRY HEAD UNIT

MODEL

F54 (Cooper S Clubman)	F55 (Cooper, Cooper S Hardtop 4 door)	F56 (Cooper, Cooper S Hardtop 2 door)	F57 (Cooper, Cooper S Convertible)
With options SA 06FP (Radio MINI Visual Boost) or SA 0606 (Navigation Business)

without options SA 0674 (Hi-Fi System Harman Kardon) or SA0 676 (Hi-fi speaker system)			

SITUATION

Volume of audio system (when set to near maximum) is reduced when Auto Start-Stop (MSA) stop occurs and is not restored upon automatic engine restart.

CAUSE

This is normal system behavior - serves to protect the head unit, battery drain and avoidance of incremental leaps in the loudness. The loudness is reduced to 2/3 of maximum and is not restored.



Note: Air conditioning output is also reduced upon MSA stop and is not restored for

similar reasons.
