### N20 and N26 engine: Smoke from Exhaust when Starting a Cold Engine

#### **NEW SITUATION**

When starting a cold engine, blue smoke can be seen emitting from the exhaust tailpipe for approximately 10-20 seconds.

No turbo charger boost faults are stored and no drivability issues can be detected.

## NEW CAUSE

When the vehicle is parked overnight the engine oil pressure will equalize and may leak past the turbo charger exhaust side turbine seal.

#### NEW PROCEDURE

Replace the engine oil feed line to the turbo charger using part number 11 42 8 648 368.

The new oil supply line will incorporate a check valve on the engine side of the engine oil feed line that will eliminate the engine oil pressure equalization via the turbo charger exhaust side turbine seal.

Refer to Repair Instruction 11 42 198 "Removing and installing oil feed line for exhaust turbocharger".

Sublet reimbursement calculation for claiming the "used quantities" of repair-related bulk materials (BMW part numbers) is at dealer net plus your center's handling.

Enter this material cost in sublet and itemize the amount on the repair order and in claim comment section.

## **Overlapping Labor – Other Repairs**

If invoicing KSD2 flat rate labor operation codes for other repair work results in overlapping labor, invoice work time (WT) labor operation 00 50 000 instead for the additional labor time needed (FRUs minus the overlapping labor).

Work time labor operation code 00 50 000 is not considered a Main labor operation.

Eligible other repair work that will be claimed under a difference defect code requires separate punch times.

On the repair order and in the claim comment section, please identify the labor operations labor operation code 00 50 000 replaces and itemize the claimed FRU amount.
