## **SUBJECT**

Ionizer Faults are Stored in the Integrated Automatic Heating/Air Conditioning

### **MODEL**

G12 (7 Series)

Vehicles produced up to October 31, 2015

Vehicles equipped with SA4NM Ambient Air Package

# NEW SITUATION

Faults are stored in IHKA (Integrated Automatic Heating/Air Conditioning):

- FC 801230 Ionizer: Internal Fault
- FC 801231 Ionizer: emitter not connected

Ionizer does not work at all.

### **CAUSE**

Software error in the Ionizer control unit

# NEW CORRECTION

Replace the Ionizer control unit if one or both faults are permanently stored in the IHKA.

## NEW PROCEDURE

Perform a vehicle test.

## Can fault 801230 and/or 801231 be cleared?

YES- disregard the faults; no repair required.

NO- replace the Ionizer control module per ISTA repair instructions "REP 64 11 974 Replace control unit for Ionizer".

Always connect a BMW approved battery charger / power supply (SI B04 23 10).
