PACCAR MX-13 EPA2013 MY2015 Replacement of Expiring Emissions Labels

Introduction

Peterbilt has determined that certain vehicles have a test exemption EPA Label that expired on December 31, 2015 that **must** be replaced with a certified EPA/CARB label.

Resolution

Review the attached chassis list for your dealer code and schedule your customer(s) for service if their chassis is on the list. Use the attached procedure. Review the DWWC or SIR for "Complete" next to the "E126" campaign code prior to performing this repair.

NOTE: This campaign should be completed immediately in order to keep the engine in EPA/CARB compliance. Failing to replace the test exemption label could result in fines up to \$37,500 per day, per non-compliant vehicle.

Warranty

There is no time or mileage limit to this campaign. Kenworth will pay for parts at dealer net plus applicable mark-up and labor:

- 0.45 hours labor (0.1 hour SRT 053-XXX remove and replace the EPA/CARB label + 0.35 hours labor to update vehicle software with DAVIE4). (Use Quick Claim Code E126A).
- File an additional claim for extraordinary circumstance. A quick claim for standard labor must be filed first.

Kenworth Vehicle Repairs:

Quick Claims cannot be used when filing claims for service performed on Kenworth Vehicles. Use the long claim input form in DWWC by selecting **Draft/Offline Claims, General** tab, and in the **Type of Claim** drop down box, select PACCAR Engine Claim. Peterbilt will pay for labor to R&R the EPA/CARB Label on your vehicle.

Procedure

Verification:

To qualify for the new label each engine must have the latest software version. To verify the software is up to date connect DAVIE4 to the vehicle and follow the procedures for software update.

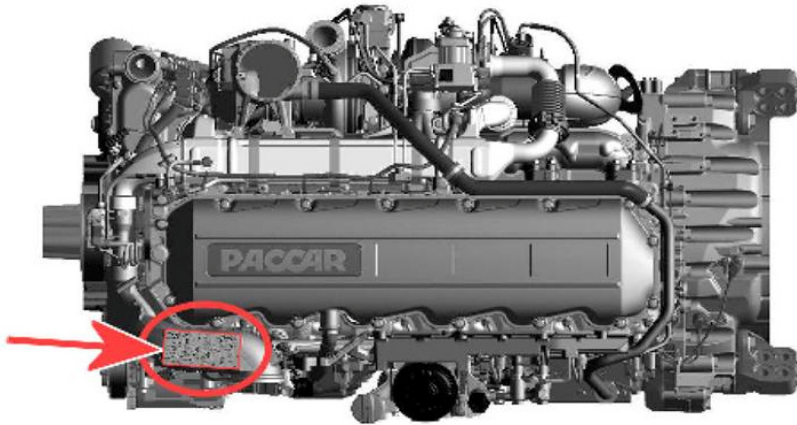
Ordering:

See attached ordering procedure.

Installation:

- 1) Remove the Test Exemption EPA/CARB label from the engine's valve cover or intake pipe. This label **MUST** be removed before installing the replacement label.

- 2) The EPA/CARB label must be placed on the intake pipe as shown below.



- 3) If the "Clean Idle Label" was not installed on the vehicle and it is desired, it will need to be ordered (Create a **SupportLink** case. Select: *I need to place an order >Label*) and installed.
