DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may experience one or more of the following conditions with the driver and/or passenger side power window(s):

- · The window glass will not raise/lower.
- The window suddenly stops operating while being raised/lowered.

DRIVER AND/OR PASSENGER SIDE POWER WINDOW WILL NOT OPERATE

• The window glass gets stuck where it stopped operating or falls down in the door.

This concern is caused by the window regulator cable end becoming disconnected from the fixing point due to improper caulking. The production facility has been improved to prevent the improper caulking of the window regulator cable.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify the customer concern
- 2. Replace the affected side window regulator(s) with a modified one(s) according to the instructions on MS3 (FRONT POWER WINDOW REGULATOR REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).
- 3. Verify the repair
