SERVICE INFORMATION

This bulletin explains the application of the passenger side upper torque rod for all **APPLIED VEHICLES**.

2013 Sentra: All models are equipped with an upper torque rod.

- These vehicles have an engine mounting insulator that requires an upper torque rod.

2014 Sentra: All SV, SL, and SR models **DO NOT HAVE** an upper torque rod. **DO NOT INSTALL an upper torque rod on these models for any reason.**

- These vehicles have a redesigned engine mounting insulator that does not require an upper torque rod.

*** 2014 Sentra:** S models built **BEFORE** 3N1AB7AP(*)EL 606447 and November 2, 2013 are equipped with an upper torque rod.

- These vehicles have an engine mounting insulator that requires an upper torque rod.

2014 Sentra: S models built **ON** and **AFTER** 3N1AB7AP(*)EL 606447 and November 2, 2013 **DO NOT HAVE** an upper torque rod. **DO NOT INSTALL an upper torque rod on these models for any reason.**

- These vehicles have a redesigned engine mounting insulator that does not require an upper torque rod.

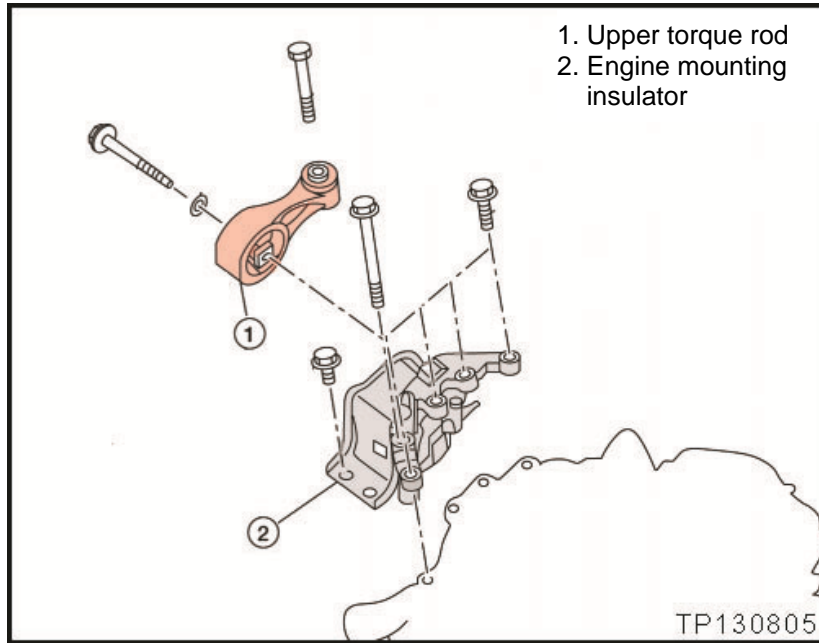

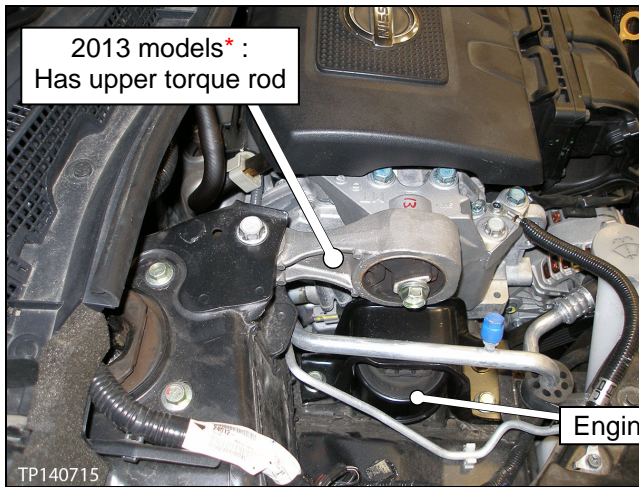

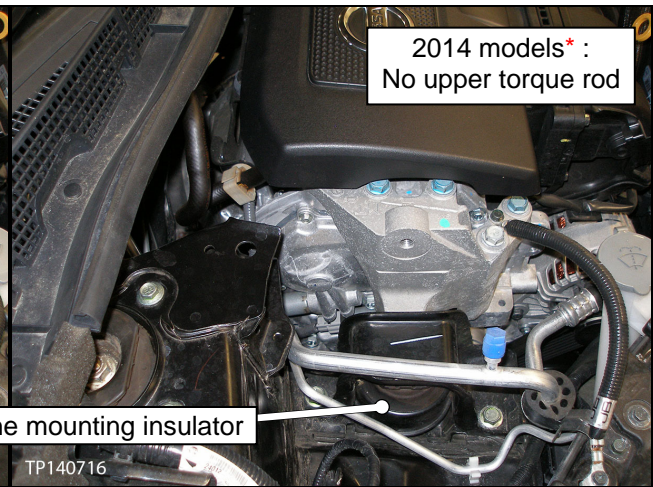
