Vehicle type: **Cayenne S E-Hybrid (92A)**

Subject: **Fuel tank readiness switch**

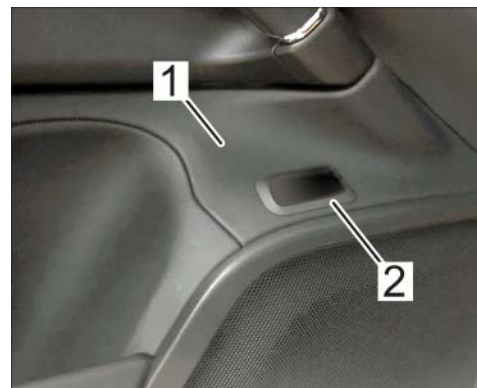
Information: **Should you receive a customer complaint regarding the fuel tank readiness switch coming loose (falling into door panel), there may be an issue with the fuel tank readiness switch and of the trim tolerances that do not meet specifications.**

The fuel tank readiness switch can fall into the door panel.

Remedial action: Securing fuel tank readiness switch in the door panel.

Parts Info: **000.043.302.57** ⇒ Adhesive (two-component adhesive)

- Work Procedure: 1 Unclip trim surround ⇒ *Unclipping trim surround -2-* from the door panel ⇒ *Unclipping trim surround -1-*.
- 2 Remove fuel tank readiness switch from the door panel using a suitable tool.
- 3 Release electric plug connection for the fuel tank readiness switch and disconnect it.

4 Affix fuel tank readiness switch in the trim surround.

4.1 Clip fuel tank readiness switch into the trim surround.

4.2 Apply adhesive between the fuel tank readiness switch and trim surround ⇒ *Affixing fuel tank readiness switch in trim surround -arrows-*.

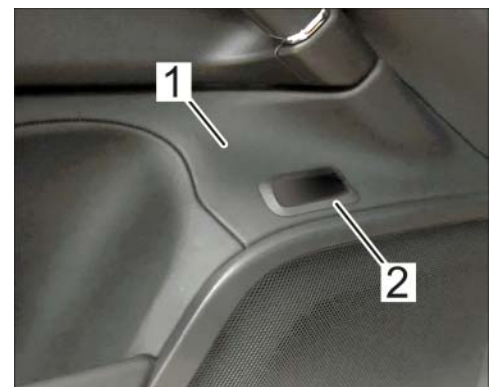
Leave adhesive to harden for 60 minutes.

5 Plug in electric plug connection on the fuel tank readiness switch.

6 Clip trim surround ⇒ *Clipping in trim surround -2-* with fuel tank readiness switch into the door panel ⇒ *Clipping in trim surround -1-*.
