Eliminating Symptoms in Body Interior: Replacing A-Pillar Trim Panel (A-pillar trim panel loose/SY0316)

Symptom: The A-pillar trim panel can become loose and stick up in the upper area between the A-pillar and roof

lining.

Model Year: As of 2015 up to 2016

Cause: Component tolerances can cause the bonding to detach and as a result, the A-pillar trim panel, to become

loose in the upper area of the A-pillar trim panel.

Date of An enhanced attachment concept has been used in production to correct this since October 13, 2015.

Introduction:

Remedial In the event of a customer complaint, replace the A-pillar trim panel at the left and right.

action: The roof lining in the adjacent upper area must also be cut.




Danger of injury and material damage if airbag units are not handled correctly!

- · Incorrect triggering of airbag unit
- ⇒ Always observe the safety regulations for handling airbag units! Safety regulations for handling airbag and seat-belt pretensioner units'
 - 2 Cut roof lining \Rightarrow Cutting roof lining -1- in the A-pillar/roof lining area.
 - Insert a suitable base between the roof lining \Rightarrow Cutting roof lining -1- and wiring harness for curtain airbag \Rightarrow Cutting roof lining -2-.
 - 2.2 Draw a cut line \Rightarrow *Cutting roof lining* -2 mm- away from the edge of the roof lining \Rightarrow *Cutting roof lining* -dashed line-.
 - 2.3 Carefully cut the roof lining \Rightarrow Cutting roof lining -1- along the marking \Rightarrow Cutting roof lining -dashed line- using a scissors.
