Rattling or Ticking From Center Panel While Driving

SYMPTOM

There is a rattling or ticking coming from the center panel while driving.

POSSIBLE CAUSES

The center panel is vibrating or rubbing against the center display visor.

CORRECTIVE ACTION

Apply wool felt behind the center panel.

DIAGNOSIS

While test-driving the vehicle, apply slight pressure to the top of the center panel. If the noise goes away, go to the REPAIR PROCEDURE. If the noise does not go away, this bulletin does not apply. Continue with normal troubleshooting.



REPAIR PROCEDURE

- When working on electronic components, make sure the work area is clean and dust-free.
- Make sure your hands are clean and free of oils and grease.
- Eject the CD before disconnecting the audio unit to prevent damaging the CD player's load mechanism.
- 1. Carefully remove both dashboard inner vents.



- 2. Remove the audio unit.
 - With display audio. (SE, EX, EX-L, Touring)
 - Remove the bolts.
 - Pull out the audio unit.
 - Disconnect the connector from the hazard warning switch.
 - Disconnect the connectors from the audio unit.
 - NOTE: There is a lever lock on audio unit connector A.

WITH DISPLAY AUDIO



- Without display audio. (LX)
 - Remove the bolts.
 - Disconnect the hazard warning switch connector and the audio unit connectors, then pull out the audio unit.
 - NOTE: There is a lever lock on audio unit connector A.



- 3. Cut two (25 mm x 5 mm) pieces of wool felt.
- 4. Apply the wool felt as shown below.





5. Install all parts in the reverse order of removal.
