2016 GMC Sierra and Yukon Models

With Ultrasonic Park Assist System (RPO UD5 or UD7)

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

Some owners may comment at times when they first start their vehicle, a "Service Park Assist" message is displayed. If they cycle the ignition off and back on, the message will be gone. When scanning for DTC's, a U0159 will be set in the IPC and/or BCM.

Note: This concern only occurs at start up and is very random. This PI does not apply to any other Park Assist DTC's, or if the issue occurs some time after start up.

Recommendation/Instructions

Engineering is currently working on an updated calibration to correct this concern. At this time, advise the customer to cycle the ignition off and then back on to clear the issue.

Please follow this diagnostic or repair process thoroughly and complete each step. If the condition exhibited is resolved without completing every step, the remaining steps do not need to be performed.
