#### Subject: Rattle Noise from Front Seat Back Easy Entry Release Handle

Condition	Some customers may comment on hearing a rattle noise coming from the driver or passenger front seat back easy entry release handle. They may note that the noise is more evident during high speed cornering.		
Cause	The cause of the condition may be a lack of lubrication on the release cable for the seat back release lever.		

### Correction

Dealership technicians are to apply lubricant to the front seat back easy entry release handle, where the seat back release cable resides, following the Service Procedure below.

#### **Service Procedure**

1. Move the headrest of the affected seat to the full upward position.

- 2. Remove the seat back latch release handle bezel. Refer to *Front Seat Back Latch Release Handle Bezel* in SI.
- 3. Fold the seat back forward.



**Note:** While detached, continue holding the cable barrel (1) with the pliers to ensure cable does not spring back within the handle.

4. Using needle nose pliers, detach the release cable barrel (1) from the latch release handle.

6. Clean off any excessive grease from the handle.

 Using a Q-tip® swab, apply GM - A/CDelco Super Lube®\* P/N 12371287 (in Canada, use P/N 10953437), or equivalent, into the cable barrel slotted housing of the plastic handle.

- 7. Reinstall the cable barrel back into the slotted handle housing (1) and verify handle operation.
- 8. Reinstall the seat back latch release handle bezel. Refer to *Front Seat Back Latch Release Handle Bezel* in SI.
- 9. Return the seat back and headrest to the original positions.
