



- Subject: Remove Flocked Material from Front Side Door Interior Trim Panel During PDI
- Models: 2013-2017 Buick Enclave
- Attention: This PI also applies to any of the above models that may be North America Export to China vehicles.

This PI has been revised to add the 2015-2017 Model Years. Please discard Pl0980.

## Condition/Concern



Two pieces of adhesive backed flocking material (black felt) are installed on the front side door interior trim panels as shown. This material is installed to protect the door panels during the build process.

## **Recommendation/Instructions**

Remove the flocking material from both front side door interior trim panels during the Pre Delivery Inspection (PDI).

Clean any adhesive residue from the trim panel. Use care to not damage the finish. For information on proper interior cleaning products, refer to the latest version of Bulletin Number 06-00-89-029.
