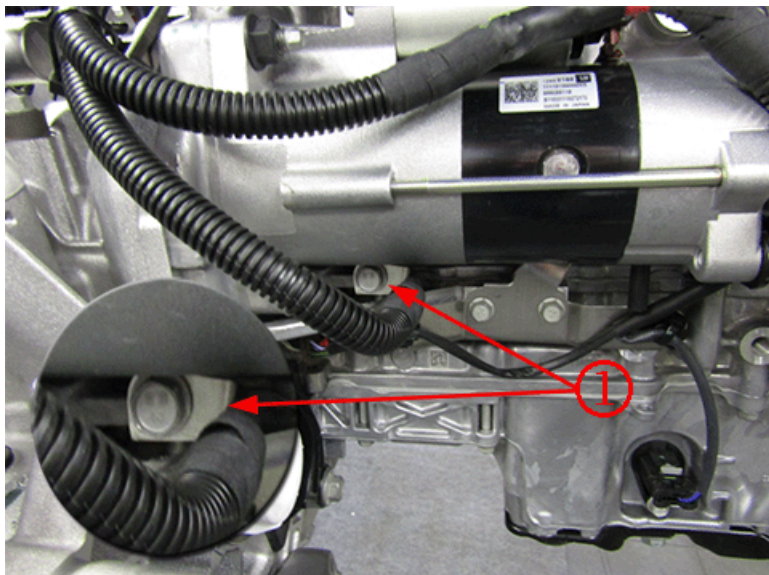

Cause	This condition could be caused by the main engine ground cable being loose.

Correction

Please inspect for the main engine ground cable located underneath the starter motor for being loose, if the ground cable is found to be loose repair as necessary.
