The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

A technician may comment of an oil leak in the high pressure fuel pump area.

Recommendation/Instructions

Engineering has determined that an oil leak in this area is most likely coming from the #6 intake cam cap at the high pressure fuel pump.

To repair this concern the technician should reseal the cam cap.

Follow SI repair procedure for "Intake Camshaft and Valve Lifter Replacement" in the on-car engine mechanical section for specific locations to apply sealer for the #6 cam cap.

Please follow this diagnostic or repair process thoroughly and complete each step. If the condition exhibited is resolved without completing every step, the remaining steps do not need to be performed.
