#### Introduction

Some Standard/Luxury grade AWD GS 350 vehicles may exhibit a front brake squeak while traveling at low speeds. A new brake pad kit is available to reduce the likelihood of this condition occurring. Use the following repair procedure to address this condition.

#### **Warranty Information (Continued)**

#### APPLICABLE WARRANTY

- This repair is covered under the Lexus Basic Warranty. This warranty is in effect for 48 months or 50,000 miles, whichever occurs first, from the vehicle's in-service date.
- Warranty application is limited to occurrence of the specified condition described in this bulletin.

#### **Repair Procedure**

- 1. Conduct a road test to verify the noise condition. Noise usually occurs during stops with light pressure applied to the brake pedal.
- 2. Did the front brake system exhibit a squeak or squeal noise?
  - YES Continue to step 3 for the front brake disc replacement.
  - NO This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.
- 3. Remove the front brake pad.

Refer to the Technical Information System (TIS), applicable model and model year Repair Manual:

- 2013 GS 350: Brake – Brake (Front) – "Brake (Front): Front Brake (for 17 inch Front Disc Brake): Removal"
- 4. Inspect the front disc as described in the Repair Manual.

Refer to TIS, applicable model and model year Repair Manual:

- 2013 GS 350: Brake – Brake (Front) – "Brake (Front): Front Brake (for 17 inch Front Disc Brake): Inspection"
- A. If the runout is more than the maximum (0.05 mm [0.00197 in.]), change the installation position of the disc to minimize runout.
- B. If the runout is more than the maximum even when the installation position is changed, machine the disc.
- C. If the disc thickness is less than the minimum (27.0 mm [1.06 in.]), replace the front disc.
- D. If the runout and disc thickness are within the maximum and minimum, continue to step 5.

### **Repair Procedure (Continued)**

5. Install the front brake pad.

- 2013 GS 350: Brake – Brake (Front) – "Brake (Front): Front Brake (for 17 inch Front Disc Brake): Installation"
- 6. Road test the vehicle to confirm the front brake squeak is no longer present.
