


This bulletin provides information on some 2016MY Optima (JFa) vehicles, produced from September 28, 2015 to February 23, 2016, which may experience a pop or click noise when driving over bumps or turning. This noise is caused by contact between the decorative trim and the sunroof frame as the chassis flexes and is more common as the vehicle heats up, causing thermal expansion of the material. To correct this concern, lubricate the contact areas by referring to the procedure below.


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SUBJECT:

SUNROOF POPPING NOISE REPAIR

Service Procedure:

1. Open sunroof shade only using the sunroof switch (A) at the overhead console.



2. Using a 90° pick, at the rear of the sunroof assembly, carefully detach the rear part of the decorative cover (B).


Use caution not to damage the headliner when removing the decorative cover.


Use caution not to damage the decorative cover as it will require replacement of the complete sunroof assembly and is not warrantable.

3. While holding the decorative cover, use an acid brush and apply a sufficient amount of lubricant on the top of the sunshade guide rail.

***** NOTICE

Protect the headliner as necessary to avoid lubricant contamination.





4. Lubricate the bottom of the decorative cover (C).



5. Carefully reattach the decorative cover by pushing the cover in until it snaps into place.



6. Thoroughly clean the excess lubricant from the decorative cover.

***** NOTICE

Ensure the headliner and sunroof glass are clean and free of lubricant.



7. Repeat steps 2-6 for the other side.
