TECHNICAL SERVICE BULLETIN

SUBJECT: TPMS SENSOR INOPERATIVE

This bulletin provides the procedure to replace all Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) sensors on 2014MY Sorento (XMa) vehicles, when any of the TPMS sensors are confirmed inoperative.

To enhance customer satisfaction, this bulletin outlines the replacement of the TPMS sensors on all 4 wheels to resolve the concern, even if only one sensor is affected.

TPMS SENSOR INOPERATIVE

Service Procedure:

- Replace all TPMS sensors by referring to the "Suspension System→ Tire Pressure Monitoring System→ TPMS Sensor→ Repair procedures" chapter in the applicable Workshop Manual on KGIS.
- 2. Verify that replacing the TPMS sensors resolved the problem.
