 Applicability has been updated to include 2015 – 2016 model year GS 350 and GS 450h vehicles and 2016 model year GS 200t vehicles.

Any previous printed versions of this bulletin should be discarded.

### Introduction

Some 2013 – 2016 model year Standard/Luxury grade 2WD GS 350 and GS 450h vehicles and 2016 model year GS 200t vehicles may exhibit a front brake squeak while traveling at slow speeds. A new brake pad kit, brake disc, and shim are available to reduce the likelihood of this condition occurring. Follow the Repair Procedure in this bulletin to address this condition.

### **Repair Procedure**

- 1. Conduct a road test to verify the noise condition. Noise usually occurs during stops with light pressure applied to the brake pedal.
- 2. Did the front brake system exhibit a squeak or squeal noise?
  - **YES** Continue to step 3 for the front brake disc replacement.

Rev1

- NO This bulletin does NOT apply. Continue diagnosis using the applicable Repair Manual.
- 3. Remove and replace the front brake disc, pad, and shim with the updated parts.

### **Repair Procedure (Continued)**

- <u>2013</u> / <u>2014</u> / <u>2015</u> / <u>2016</u> GS 450h: Brake – Brake (Front) – "Brake (Front): Front Brake (for 17 inch Front Disc Brake): Installation"
- <u>2016</u> GS 200t: Brake – Brake (Front) – "Brake (Front): Front Brake (for 17 inch Front Disc Brake): Installation"

### **NOTE** Do NOT turn or grind the new rotors.

4. Road test the vehicle to confirm the front brake squeak is no longer present.
