2016 MAZDA3 (MEXICO BUILT - VINS STARTING WITH 3MZ) - THEFT PREVENTION FOR SECONDARY KEY FOB AND MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

Content

To minimize theft during transportation, the secondary key fob and miscellaneous items will remain hidden in the cargo area, but the door lock fuse will no longer need to be installed at the dealer as it will arrive installed from the plant. NOTE that door locks and trunk operation are NO LONGER temporarily disabled since the fuse is NOT removed. Open the attached pdf for information on how to retrieve these items.

Miscellaneous Items Retrieval Instructions

Retrieve the secondary key fob hidden in the cargo area by following the (2) steps below.

<p>1. Locate the trunk release and engage the trunk release button</p>	<p>1. Locate the jack compartment and remove the jack compartment lid. 2. Locate and remove the hidden accessory bag from the jack compartment area. 3. Retrieve the accessory bag and locate the secondary key fob. If secondary key fob is missing, please order new key fob and blank key. Cut new blank key and program fob by perform the erase and program new key function in IDS > PATS function. (Please charge missing items as transportation claim) 4. Close and secure the jack compartment lid and continue normal PDI process with the remaining miscellaneous items.</p>
