2013-2016 CX-5 vehicles equipped with automatic transmission

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain about a vibration that is felt through the floor, seat and/or steering wheel while driving under moderate acceleration, at speeds of approx. 25 - 30 mph (40 - 50 km/h). The vibration is more noticeable when driving on smooth, flat roads.

The vibration may be caused by wear on the inner surface of the tripod joint case (inner side of front drive shaft). To eliminate this concern, a coating has been applied to the inner surface of the tripod joint case to improve wear resistance.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE


- 1. Verify the customer concern.
- Replace the inner joint set for the left and right drive shafts with modified service parts according to the instructions on MS3 online (FRONT DRIVE SHAFT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION) and (FRONT DRIVE SHAFT (TRIPOD JOINT) DISASSEMBLY/ASSEMBLY).
- 3. Verify the repair.
