
Introduction

Some 2014 – 2015 model year Yaris vehicles may exhibit a condition where there is an excessive gap between the rear bumper and the body due to a partial separation between the retainer and the bumper cover. Resecuring the rear bumper cover may not sufficiently prevent this gap from returning. The Rear Bumper Retainer has been revised to provide additional retention force to the rear bumper cover. Follow the Repair Procedure in this bulletin to address this concern.

NOTE

Some uniform gaps between the body and rear bumper cover is permissible and repairing uneven gaps as a result of collision damage is NOT a warrantable condition.

Repair Procedure

1. Remove the rear bumper as per the Repair Manual.

Refer to the Technical Information System (TIS), applicable model and model year Repair Manual:

- 2014 Yaris: Vehicle Exterior – Exterior Panels/Trim – "Exterior Panels/Trim: Rear Bumper (for hatchback with Sport Package): <u>Removal</u>"
- 2015 Yaris: Vehicle Exterior – Exterior Panels/Trim – "Exterior Panels/Trim: Rear Bumper (for hatchback): Removal"

HINT

- Apply protective tape as shown in the illustrations to prevent damage.
- After removing the rear bumper, use care when storing the rear bumper cover to prevent damage to the finish.



Repair Procedure (Continued)

2. Remove the rear bumper cover retainer by uninstalling the (1) 10mm screw and disengaging the retainer from the body by prying against the body as shown.



3. Install new retainers by engaging the retainers with the body.

 "Exterior Panels/Trim: Rear Bumper (for hatchback with Sport Package): Reassembly"
- 2015 Yaris:
 Vehicle Exterior Exterior Panels/Trim
 "Exterior Panels/Trim: Rear Bumper (for hatchback): Reassembly"

HINT

Avoid over tightening the retainer screw.

NOTE

Repeat for the opposite side.




Repair Procedure (Continued)

4. Remove protective tape after confirming the bumper cover is secure.

NOTE

Installation of the rear bumper cover is reverse of removal.

- 5. Confirm rear bumper gap is less than 1.6mm and is consistent.
